ROMAN JEWELLERY

Roman jewellery was mainly made of gold and was decorated with precious stones and beads made of glass. Gold coins were often used too. Roman men were only allowed to wear one, sometimes two items of jewellery, this was usually a ring and a brooch for his cloak. Roman women wore earrings, bracelets, necklaces, pendants, bracelets, rings and different types of head jewellery like tiaras and head bands. Gold bracelets were often styled in the form of snakes. Necklaces were made with different sized of beads with lots of colour and patterns.
